

Prices 2021-2022

The prices below are the 2021 – 2022 school year fees for your candidates in full time education with a 10% reduction and are as follows for the B2, C1 and C2 levels.

2021-2022 – with and without the retake insurance option

B2 First and First for Schools 346.50Chf discount price instead of 385.00Chf

B2 First and First for Schools 366.50Chf discount price instead of 405.00Chf with the retake option* (see below for details and refer to the enclosed Terms and Conditions).

If a student has financial issues and consequently problems paying for the exam, we can provide a payment plan for him/her. The payment can be made in several installments if necessary. If you know of a candidate in this situation, please ask him/her to contact us to see what our Cambridge centre can provide as a solution. This information remains strictly confidential between Cambridge English Examinations Valais SàRL and the candidate.

*Candidates who choose to add the retake option insurance to the price of their examination will be able to take the exam again free of charge in the next 12 months (from the date of their examination) in the case that they fail their exam by **4 points or less**.

The fee for the re-take insurance is the same for all levels of the Cambridge English Examinations:
20.00 CHF

- A2 KET / KET for Schools / B1 PET / PET for Schools / BEC Preliminary
- B2 First /First for Schools / C1 Advanced/C2 Proficiency/B2 BEC Vantage / C1 BEC Higher

The Centre must be contacted by the candidate within 15 days of the official examination result release date.

The resit must be taken within 12 months of the official examination result release date.

The re-take insurance is only valid for the same examination which was failed and in the same Centre.

One further issue – if you have a student with a disability or learning difference they need to inform us **immediately when entering for the examination** so that we can organize with Cambridge Assessment English everything necessary , i.e. extra time/special papers for impaired vision or hearing. They will need to provide a medical certificate which they can send to us electronically **at the time** of entry.
